• **Para Athletics\***

- This competition offers **national classification** for Para Athletics. Para Athletics was not approved by World Para Athletics (WPA), and therefore, international classification will not be conducted as part of EPYG 2025.
- As the LOC, we will organize national classification before the event. Please note that this **national classification will be limited to PI (Physical Impairment)** athletes only. **There will be no classification for VI (Visual Impairment) or II (Intellectual Impairment)** athletes, and VI and II athletes are expected to undergo classification in their respective countries.

- Participation in this national classification is not mandatory

**Classification dates are as follow:**

- Monday 21.7
- Tuesday 22.7
- Wednesday 23.7
- Thursday 24.7.

An athlete will only be permitted to undergo International Classification if he or she:

- Is licensed with International Federations (IFs) for the 2025 Season
- Has been entered into the competition by the classification entry deadline.

Classification will take place in İBB Cebeci Sports Complex, except for Para Taekwondo. **Para Taekwondo** classification will be held in in **Pullman Hotel**.

Classification results will be published in accordance with the rules of each international federation.

**Classification –VI Athletes (Ophthalmological Examinations)**

- The ophthalmological assessments for athletes with visual impairment athletes (Goalball, Judo and Para Swimming) will take place at the following clinic:

**Başakşehir Çam and Sakura City Hospital Başakşehir Mahallesi, G-434 Caddesi No: 2L Başakşehir / İSTANBUL <https://camsakurasehir.saglik.gov.tr/>**

- ‘Travel time approximately 10 minutes from dormitory’.. Transportation from the athlete village the hospital will be provided by the LOC, in accordance with each athlete’s individual classification schedule.



**Classification Regulations**

- IFs will schedule athletes with a New, Review or Review Fixed Date (RFD) status pursuant with the current rules and regulations.
- Please note that all athletes must comply with the following conditions before being accredited to the event: all athletes need to follow participation criteria as per sport.
- All athletes for the classification need to have a fully filled, dated and signed Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) and related documents as per Classification Rules relevant to the Sport.
- MDF forms need to be uploaded into the database that relevant sport is using (SDMS; ISAS; etc) with the relevant timeline per Classification rules.

- The MDF’s will be thoroughly checked after they have been uploaded. Athletes without the correct MDF uploaded in due time will not be scheduled for classification and cannot enter the competition. There will be no exceptions.

- Athletes using assistive devices must comply with classification rules.






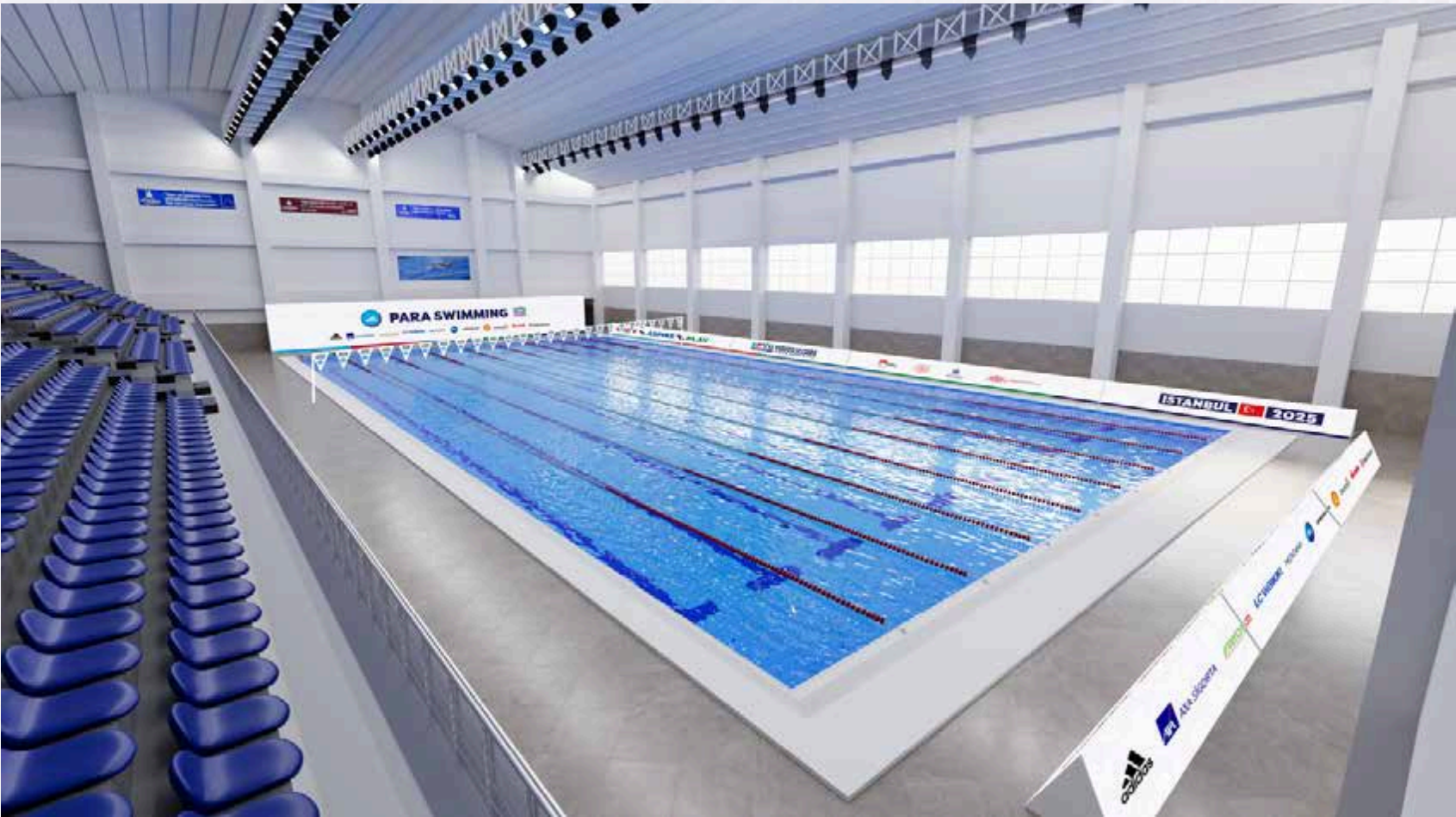

**Age Rule:**

The minimum is 12 years old the maximum is 18. The age will be considered as on as on 31 December in the year of competition.

**Age Category:**

Junior male: 2009-2013

Junior female: 2010-2013

Senior male: 2007-2008

Senior female: 2007-2009

Event Viability:

Minimum of four (4) athlete entries from two (2) NPCs is necessary to sustain an individual event on the programme. Should an athletes individual event not be viable at close of entry, they may swim up to the next available class as per WPS Rules and Regulations.

**Athlete Eligibility**

Swimmers must:

- Hold an active World Para Swimming license for the Season 2025.
- be entered by their NPC or NF, with the NPC being a good standing member of IPC in EPYG portal and SDMS
- be minimum 12 years old and the maximum is 18 years old by 31st December in the year of the competition.
- an athlete must have an International Classification status of Review (R), Fixed Review Date (FRD) or Have a classification status Confirmed (C) to medal.
- Any athlete on a New (N) Status not undergoing classification in the EPYG2025 may only swim in heats and will not progress to finals.
- Only Athletes with Fixed Review Date (FRD) 2026 or later, or Confirmed (C) status are eligible for medals.

**Classification:**

Para Swimming classification will be ran under current World Para Swimming (WPS) Classification Rules and Regulations in 2022. International classification will happen international classification before the start of the competition. WPS will schedule an international classification for physically impaired (PI), visually impaired (VI) and intellectually impaired (II) athletes with new, review or FDR status 2025 or earlier. For VI athletes, IBSA will conduct centrally all VI classification processes during the games.

**Competition Format**

The competition will be swam under WPS Rules and Regulations 2024. Events will be swam as multi-class event. Medals will be presented in single class format. All medals are subject to minus 1 rule.

Para Judo athletes will be classified under current IBSA Classification Rules and Regulations in 2018. Athletes need to have international classification before the start of the competition. IBSA will schedule and conduct the classification centrally for athletes with a New, Review or RFD status pursuant with the current rules and regulations during the games.

### Competition Format

The competition format shall follow the standard IBSA Judo procedures, depending on the number of athletes in each weight category: a double repechage system will be used if there are 6 or more athletes, while a round robin format will apply for categories with 3 to 5 athletes.

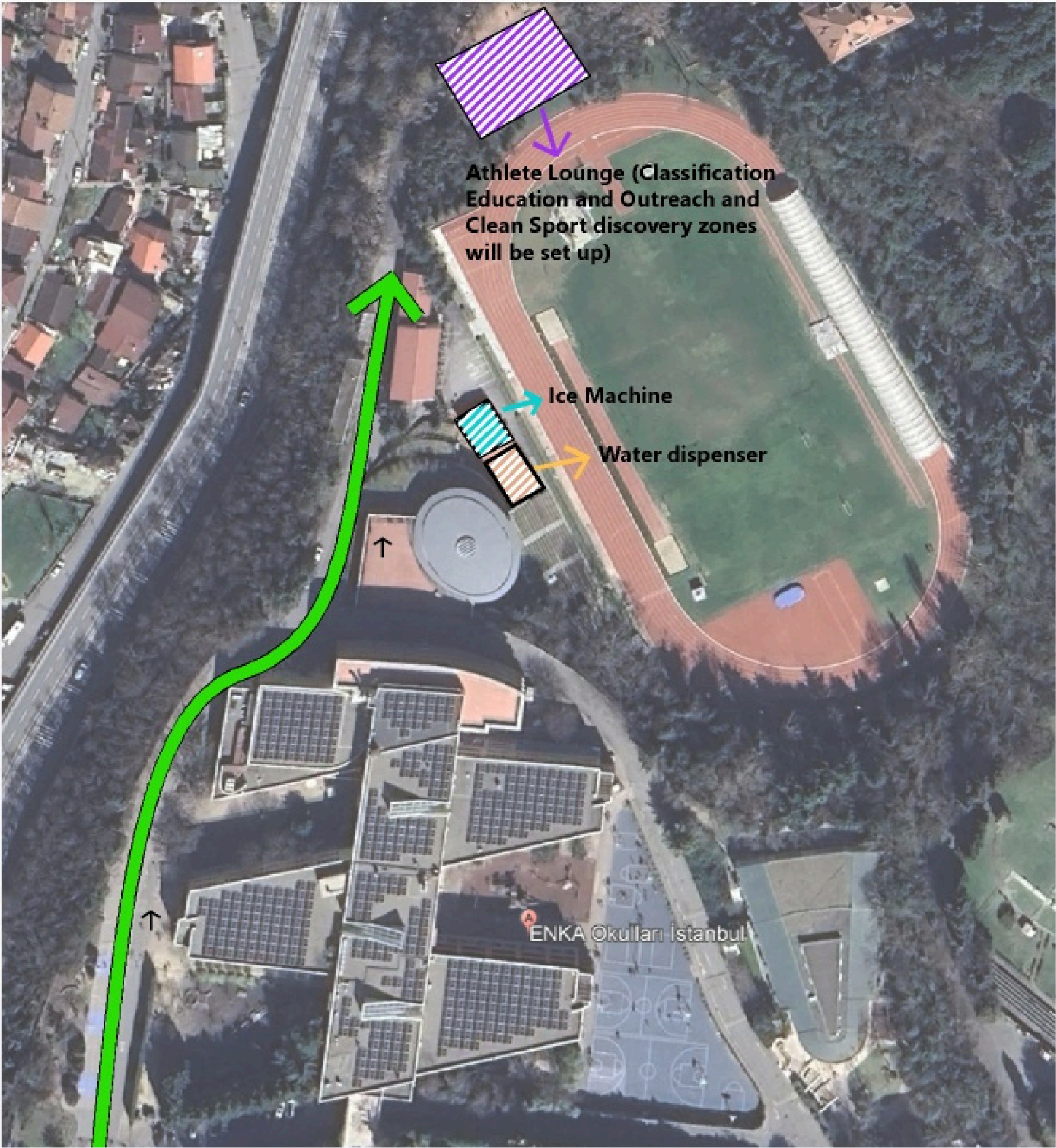

# WHEELCHAIR STORAGE

Recognizing that our Wheelchair Basketball Athletes need to change wheelchairs before matches and prioritizing the security of their equipment, we have designated a dedicated storage area for this purpose. The area indicated with a **black dot** on the previous page has been allocated accordingly. Prior to their matches, athletes will access this room to perform wheelchair changes and will then return to their respective courts to compete.

Furthermore, to ensure our athletes' comfort and to avoid overcrowding, we have provided four accessible changing rooms and toilet facilities.

# ICE MACHINE

## **Block A:**

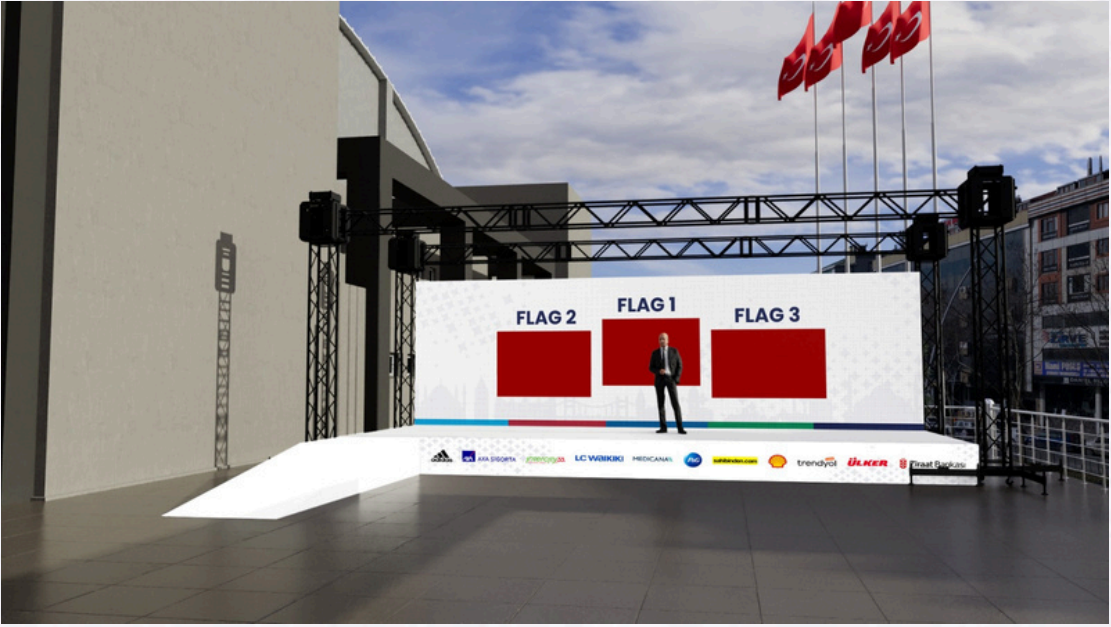
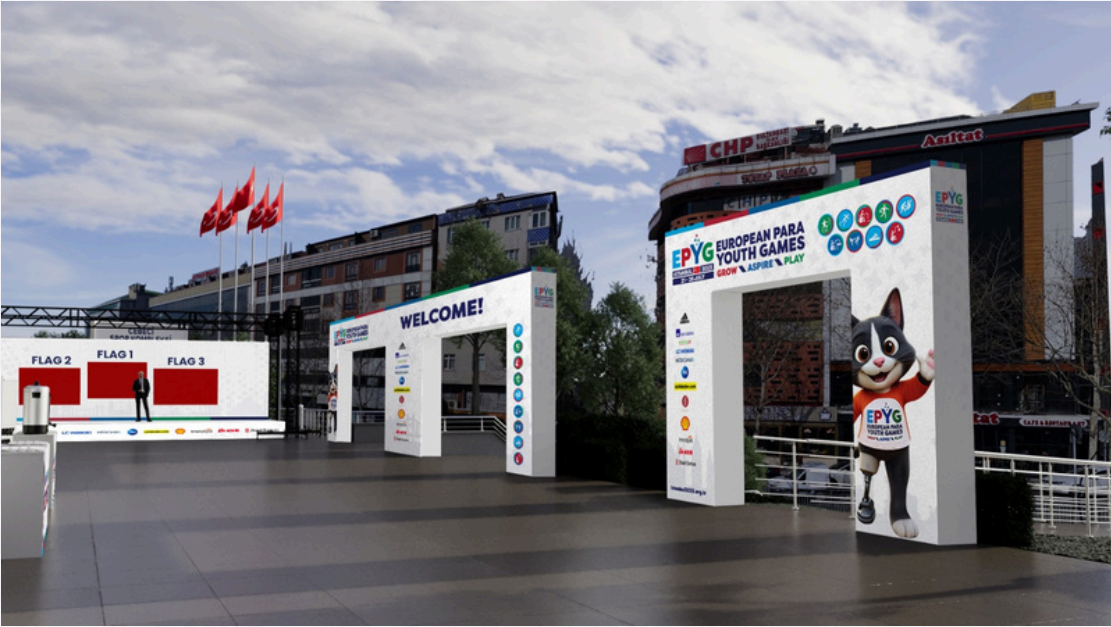
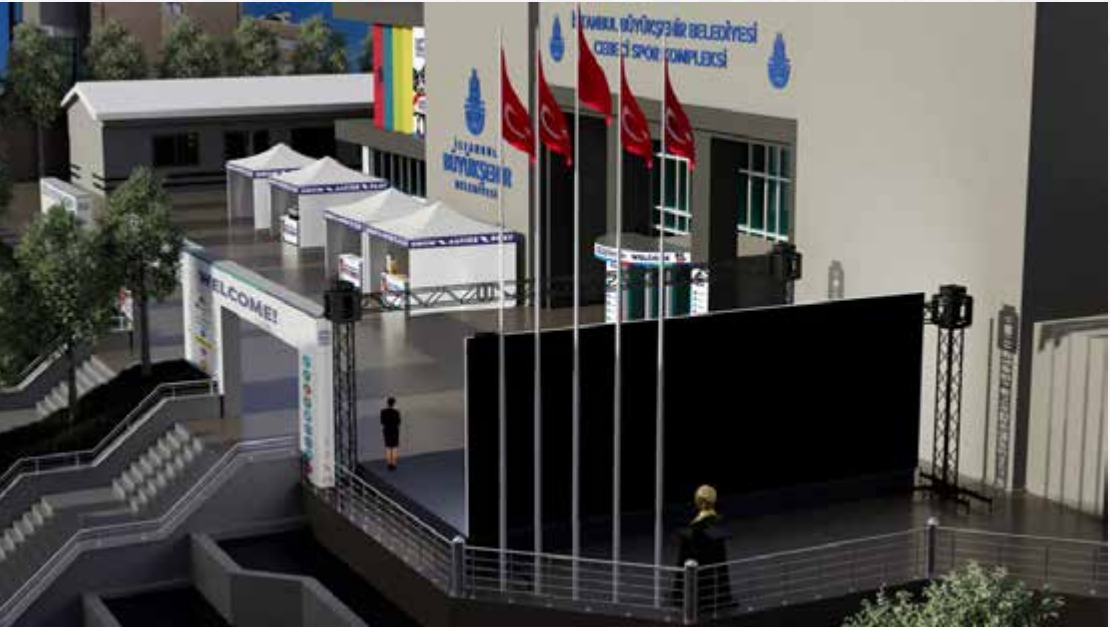

# FUN ZONE



FunZone will serve as the central hub where the event engages with spectators ,hosts Discovery Program activities, and features sponsor booths offering interactive and engaging experiences.

Medal ceremonies will be held on the stage located within the Fun Zone, immediately following the conclusion of competitions. The area is fully accessible for athletes, ensuring inclusivity for all participants.

# ATHLETES’ LOUNGE

two suitable areas have been identified to serve this purpose:

### 1.The Waiting Area at the Entrance of B Block :

This space is redesigned to accommodate athletes. It will serve as a social and relaxation zone, including:

- Comfortable seating
- A transportation desk to follow competition schedules and announcements
- Recreational activities such as football and billiards
- A drinks and snack station

The aim is to provide athletes with a comfortable environment to relax, socialize, and engage between their competitions.

### 2. Outdoor Athletes lounge

A secondary rest zone will be established using a portable structure in front of Block B. This additional space is intended to prevent over crowding in a single area and to offer athletes an alternative option for rest and recovery. open air.

The right section of this area will be designated as a social space for referees and delegates. A portable wall or curtain divider will be installed between the two areas to ensure privacy and a dedicated atmosphere for each group.



# MEDICAL REPAIR SERVICES

We aim to ensure that our athletes' orthosis & prostheses and wheelchairs are not damaged during the event. However, we are aware that such situations may still occur. Therefore, we have arranged 2 different companies for support in **Cebeci Sports Complex - Fun Zone Area.**

- All changes to be made from this date onwards must be reported by e-mail.
- In the event of **any updates or changes to flight information**, delegations must inform the LOC Responsible Person via e-mail

# OPENING CEREMONY

# FLAG PARADE

All participating countries are expected to take part in the Opening Ceremony Parade. Below is the detailed flow and requirements:

## General Information

- All athletes are expected to join the parade wearing their official national team uniforms.
- One volunteer will be assigned to assist each country's delegation.

## Pre-Parade Assembly

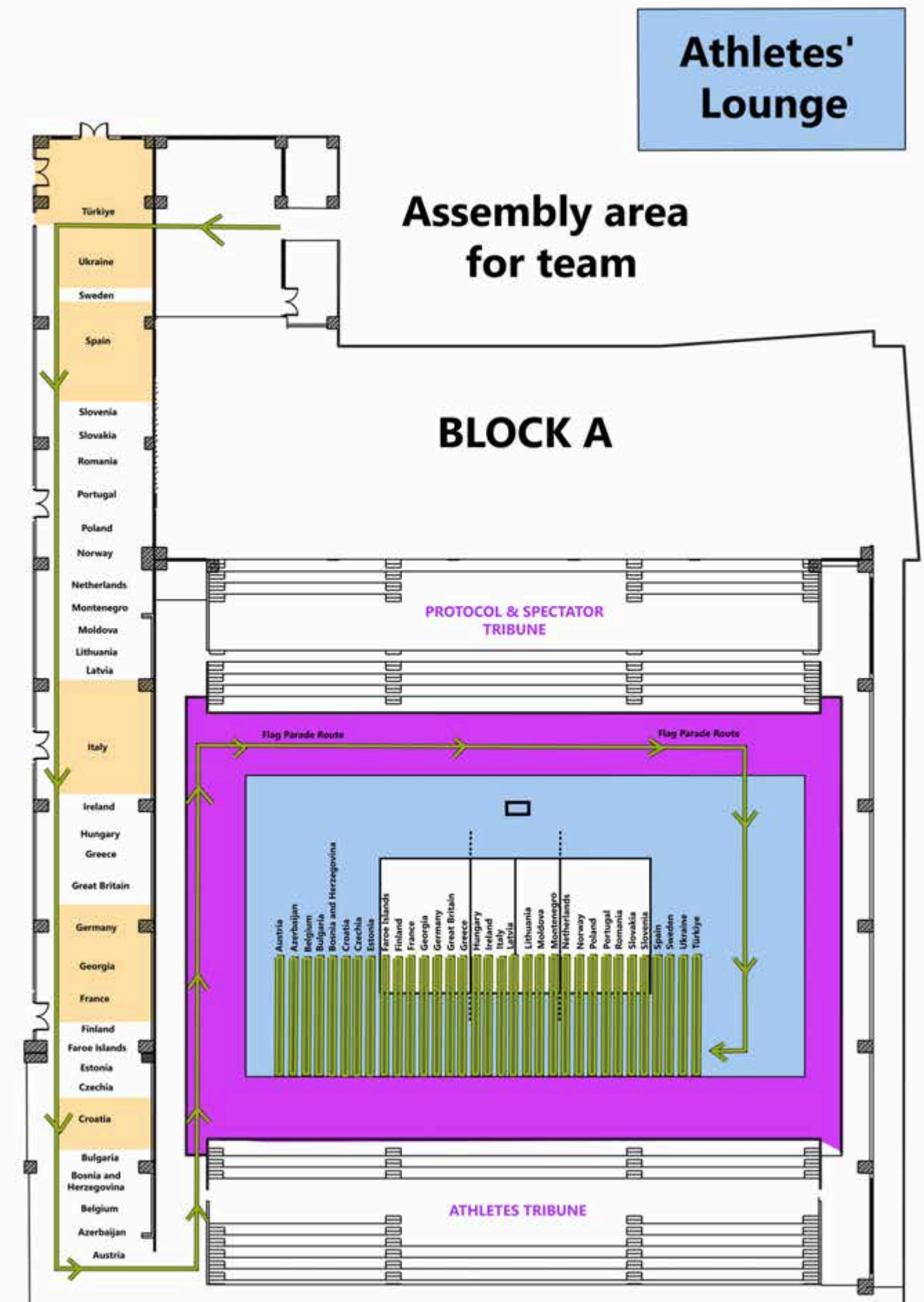
- All teams participating in the parade must gather at the Outdoor Athletes Lounge at least 45 minutes before the ceremony begins.
- This gathering area will serve as the preparation and line-up zone for the delegations.
- Country sign will be held by assigned volunteers to help each delegation locate their position.

## Parade Formation

- Delegations will be lined up in alphabetical order based on their country's English name.
- The host country will enter last in the parade, following all other nations.
- Volunteers will assist in organizing teams according to the number of athletes and ensure a smooth entry flow.

## Parade March

- Once the lineup is complete, delegations will begin the march into the Opening Ceremony venue.
- The parade will culminate in a symbolic celebratory walk, marking the official opening of the event.





# CLOSING CEREMONY

The Closing Ceremony of the European Para Youth Games 2025 will be held on the evening of 27 July in a gala format. It will take place at 8:00 PM.

## ◆ Dress Code

- The Closing Ceremony will have a smart casual dress code for staff and non-athlete participants.
- Athletes, on the other hand, must wear their official national team uniforms during gala.

On this special night, athletes from participating countries, technical teams, volunteers, guests, and sponsors will come together to once again experience the spirit of unity, friendship, and fair play that defines the European Para Youth Games.

# MEDAL CEREMONY

The medal ceremonies to be held during the European Para Youth Games (EPYG) 2025. All medal ceremonies for the sports held at the Cebeci Sports Complex will take place in the dedicated Medal Ceremony Area, which will be set up within the Fun Zone, following the conclusion of the respective finals. The ceremonies will be conducted in a respectful and dignified manner, in line with international protocol standards. Athletes are expected to attend the medal ceremonies wearing their official national team uniforms.

In planning the medal ceremonies, the following objectives are prioritized:

- Ensuring ceremonies do not disrupt the overall flow of the event,
- Scheduling in harmony with the competition timetable,

# ACCOMMODATION & CATERING





# ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation centers will host approximately 1,300 athletes and team officials. The main accommodation center is **Kanuni Sultan Süleyman (KSS) Dormitory**.

All delegations (except Boccia players) will be accommodated at KSS Dormitory. Boccia players and EPC members will stay at the Pullman Hotel & Convention Center. Room allocations will follow the rooming lists submitted to the LOC by the NPCs.

The dormitory consists of 8 floors; **-1 and -3 floors** are specifically adapted to meet the needs of wheelchair users. All accommodation places are adapted with maximum accessibility to meet the needs of the participants.

**The general house rules** of each accommodation facility must be respected. These will be shared upon arrival. The Kanuni Sultan Süleyman Dormitory is secured 24/7 by professional on-site security staff to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants throughout the event.

**Quiet hours** will be from 22:30 to 05:00 to ensure all residents have a peaceful rest. The EPYG 2025 Organising Committee does not permit the consumption, sale, or distribution of alcohol, cigarettes, cigars, or similar products. Smoking is strictly prohibited in all accommodation areas, including balconies.

Failure to comply with the general house rules of the accommodation facilities may result in a penalty fee of €50, imposed following verification by the LOC.

All participants accommodated at the Kanuni Sultan Süleyman Dormitory will receive a **welcome kit**, which includes personal hygiene and promotional items provided by EPYG 2025 sponsors.



# CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT

Upon arrival at the accommodation places, Delegations will be allowed to check in upon arrival and are required to visit the information desk. The designated LOC staff will review the rooming list with the team representative and confirm the final delegation list. Once the verification is complete, volunteers will accompany the delegation to their rooms.

**Room keys** will be issued to the team manager following this confirmation.

Teams are responsible for their room keys, and all keys must be returned to the LOC representative before departure.

A penalty of €50 applies in case of room key loss. Lost keys must be reported to the LOC immediately, and replacements will be issued upon payment of the fee.

## ON-SITE SERVICES & FACILITIES

Housekeeping services will be provided regularly – in every 2 days – at the Kanuni Sultan Süleyman Dormitory. Participants may indicate their housekeeping preference by placing the designated door hanger card.

**Laundry services** will be available at the dormitory free of charge and operate daily between 08:00 and 22:00.

Detergent will be provided by the LOC. Participants are expected to carry out their own laundry using the designated self-service laundry area within the dormitory.

**Free Wi-Fi** will be available in all accommodations, with passwords provided at the info desks.

**Info desks** operate daily from 08:00 to 20:00 and provide general information, internet access, transportation schedules, and other EPYG-related services. Important updates will be posted on info boards.

# CATERING

EPYG 2025 will provide food and beverage services designed to meet the performance and dietary needs of athletes and team officials. Daily meals will be served buffet-style in the dining hall of KSS Dormitory and the other accommodation centers.

The EPYG 2025 menu offers a wide variety of culturally inclusive meals, taking into account nutritional, vegetarian, and religious requirements. Allergen and nutritional information will be clearly labeled at the buffet in both Turkish and English. We kindly ask you not to drink tap water; however, you are welcome to take your water bottles at the dining hall during the meals hours.

Lunch Box Distribution will take place at the **Athletes' Lounge** at the Cebeci Sports Complex.

Each team manager is responsible for informing the LOC of the number of lunch boxes required for the next day.

Team managers are expected to fill out the **Lunch Box Request Form** — available at the info desks. Request forms for the following day must be submitted to info desk between **09.00 to 12.00**. Participants are expected to select one lunch option only.



# ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation Centre is located at the Cebeci Sports Complex and operates from 22 to 24 July between 08.00 - 18.00.

Accreditation cards will be handed over to a **single designated team representative**, who will be responsible for collecting the cards for their entire delegation.

Accreditation cards will only be delivered after the confirmation of payment and approval of participation invoices.

**Each country must inform the LOC in advance about the appointed representative who will collect the accreditation cards from the Accreditation Center.**

Once distributed, each individual is responsible for their own card. A penalty of €50 applies in case of accreditation card loss. Lost cards must be reported immediately to the LOC, and a replacement will only be issued after the penalty is paid.

Accreditation must be worn at all times to access competition areas and secure zones. Security checkpoints will be in place throughout the event.

The portal deadline for accreditation submissions is set for 1 July 2025.

After this deadline, only LOC-approved new accreditation requests are printed on-site at the Accreditation Centre. NPCs must inform LOC representatives about any new submissions or changes to the delegation.

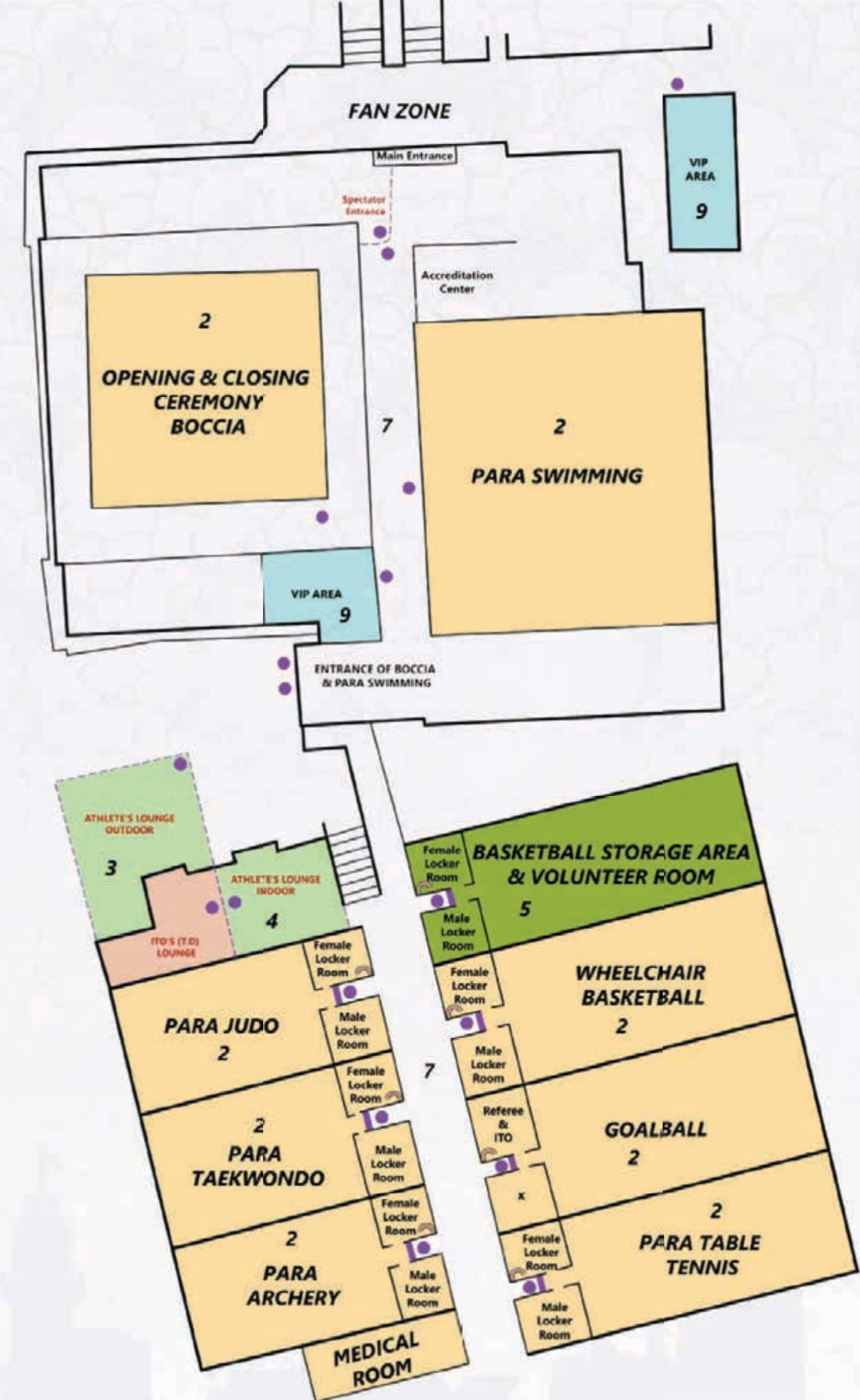
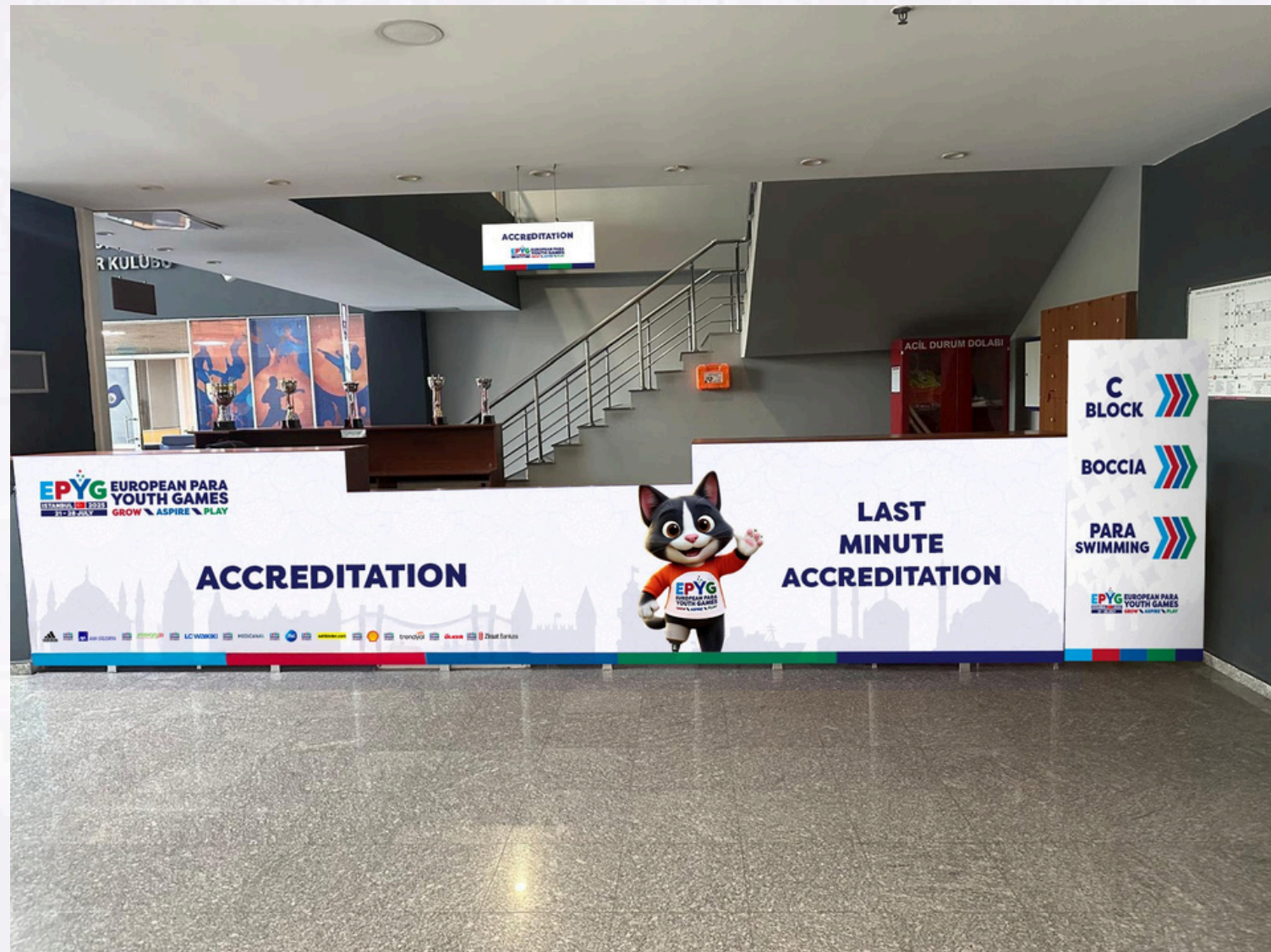


# ACCREDITATION ZONE

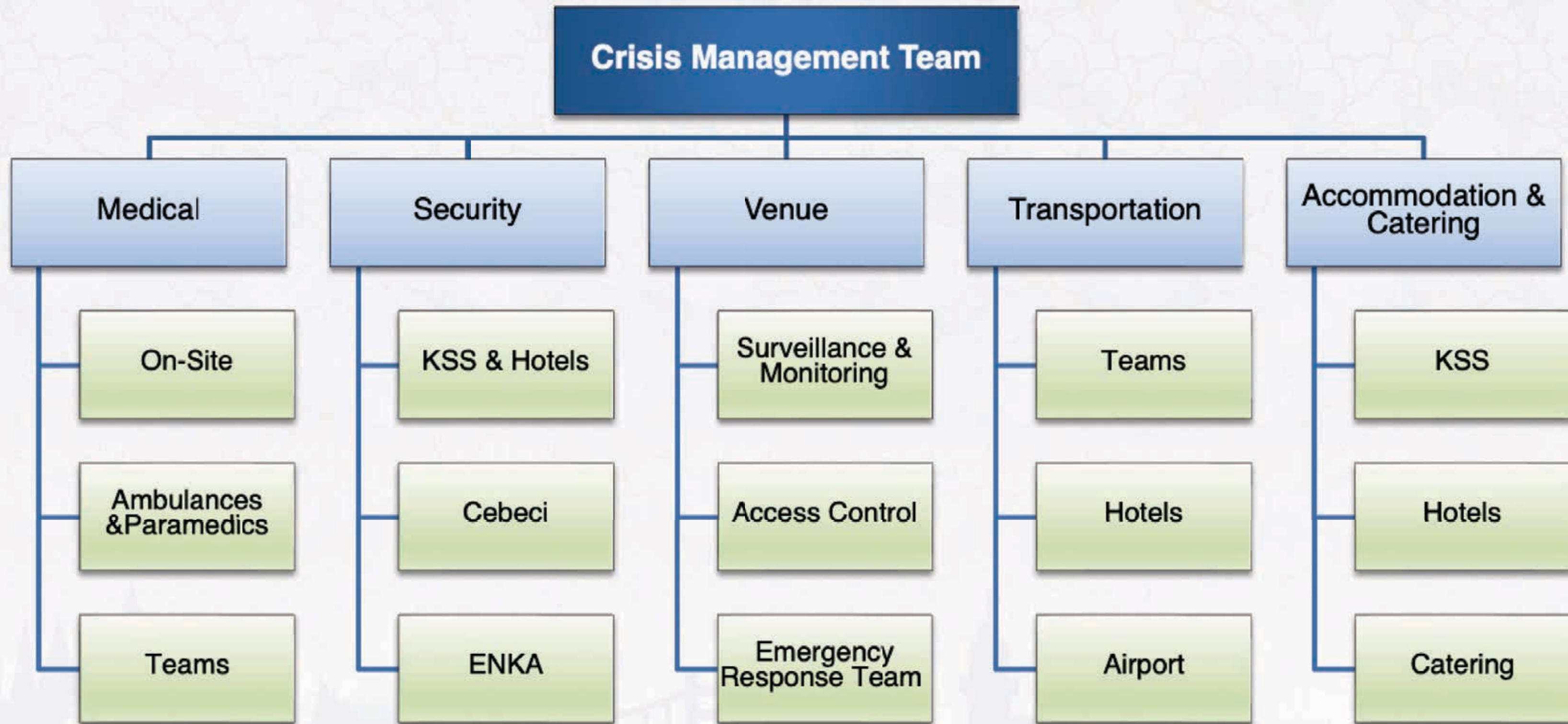
