1. Venue Overview

The competition will be held at “Schwimm- & Sprunghalle im Europasportpark” (SSE) in Berlin. The 3.000 seat facility features a 10 lane 50m competition pool and a 10 lane 50m warm-up pool.

1.1. Parking

Parking is available in the vicinity of the competition venue. Access to the venue's car park requires a valid parking or transit permit. Due to the limited capacity of the car park, permits will be issued exclusively to wheelchair users or athletes with severe mobility impairments who are travelling in their own vehicle.

To apply for parking or transit permits for the competition venue, please send an email to paraswimming@roughwaterand.com. Only applications received no later than **20 April 2026** will be considered. Approved permits can be collected at the accreditation desk.

2. Traveling to Berlin

2.1. By Plane

Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER) is the nearest airport, located approximately 60 minutes (26km) from the venue. Transfers will be arranged upon arrival at this airport for delegations whose reservations at one of the official hotels have been made through and confirmed by the Local Organizing Committee.

2.2. By Train

Berlin offers rail connections from across Germany and Europe.

The following long-distance stations provide convenient access to the venue and the official hotels. Considering Berlin's city traffic, it is recommended to take the S-Bahn or tram to "Landsberger Allee" station, which is located directly opposite the venue and close to the official hotels. Transfers from one of the railway stations mentioned below may be arranged upon request for delegations whose reservations at one of the official hotels have been made through and confirmed by the Local Organizing Committee.

Berlin Central Station (Hauptbahnhof)

Berlin Central Station is Berlin's main railway hub, welcoming trains from all major German and European cities. The venue is easily accessible within approximately 25 minutes by tram lines M8 or M5. Transfer by car is 25 to 35 minutes (8km).

Berlin East Station (Ostbahnhof)

Berlin East Station offers connections for guests arriving from eastern regions. The venue is conveniently accessible within approximately 15 minutes by taking the S3, S5 or S7 to Ostkreuz and continuing on the S8, S42 or S85. Transfer by car is 15 to 25 minutes (4km).

Berlin Gesundbrunnen

Berlin Gesundbrunnen serves as an important northern gateway to the city, with frequent long-distance and regional train services. From Gesundbrunnen you can take the S41 and reach the Venue in just 7 minutes. By car the venue is reachable in 15 to 20 minutes (6km).

Please note that if you arrive at any airport or station not listed above, the LOC will not be able to offer transportation to the hotel/venue. You will need to make your own way to one of the listed airports or stations to access LOC-provided transportation. Otherwise, you will need to arrange your own travel to the hotel/venue.

3. Visas

Each team is responsible to ensure they have the proper documentation to enter Germany.

Entries must be submitted electronically via the online registration system. The link to the registration system will be published shortly on the [event website](#).

By submitting the entry, the signatory confirms that he/she is authorized to create and submit the entries. Furthermore, the signatory confirms that all swimmers entered are eligible to compete for the club/NPC submitting the entry.

ATTENTION! Each club/NPC is responsible for ensuring that entries are submitted on time. Late entries or changes to entries are not permitted. Late or incomplete entries will not be considered.

After receiving the registrations, each club/NPC will receive only an electronic confirmation containing the number and list of registrations received (please provide an email address for this purpose; no notification will be sent by post). The registration confirmation must be checked immediately – any discrepancies must be sent to the registration address within 48 hours! Later changes will be charged at EUR 5 per change.

Entry fees do not include accommodation, transport in Berlin and meals!

The registration fee must be transferred immediately, but no later than **Friday, 17 April 2026**, to the account specified below. A late payment fee of EUR 20 will be charged for any payments not received by the deadline.

Please note: If you cancel after the registration deadline, the registration fee will be retained by the organizer. **Cash payments on site are not possible.**

6. Competition Format and Schedule

The competition will be run under World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations. The competition is open for swimmers with a physical, a visual or an intellectual impairment. Competitions for the classes S1 - S14 will be offered. Seeding will be done according to entry times and independently of classification. All rankings will be done by the German 1000 Point System.

The event schedule can be found in the attachment. For all changes and updates, please check the event website.

7. Swimmers Eligibility

WPS licensed Swimmers have to enter the event using their WPS SDMS ID and their current World Para Swimming classification which may be found online at <https://www.paralympic.org/swimming/classification/masterlist>

International Swimmers without an international classification will be allowed to take part in the heats and finals with their national classification and exceptions. It is the responsibility of the entering federation or club to enter the exceptions for these swimmers at the entry portal in case of participation with national classification. The competitor will be handled like an able-bodied swimmer without entered exceptions.

8. Rules & Regulations

For all events, the current World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations ([WPS Rules & Regulations](#)) apply. The multiclass format by points (German 1000-point system) will be in use for the IDM. The following amendments to the World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply for this competition:

9. Restrictions for Competition Entries:

Due to the German Youth Protection Act swimmers born in 2016 may compete a maximum of six times (6x including finals and relays!) per day. Entries for swimmers born in 2016 in the 400m individual medley and 200m butterfly are not permitted. Please note that entries that do not comply with this paragraph will be automatically cancelled. The entry fee will be retained by the organizer.

The 150m individual medley is exclusively for start classes SM1-4. If there are fewer than 10 participants, a heat will still be held.

Only two heats will be held in the open class for the 400m individual medley for female/male competitors. The 20 best entries according to the DBS – Para Swimming Department 1000-point table will be considered. Competitors born in 2016 are not eligible to participate in these competitions.

For the 400m freestyle female/male, the best 40 entries in the open class and the ten best entries in the Masters (Masters I-III) according to the 1000-point table of the DBS – Para Swimming Department will be considered for the heats. There are no entry restrictions for the youth classes.

All entries exceeding this limit will be rejected. In such cases, written notification will be sent after the registration deadline. The registration fee will be refunded.

Athletes from federations banned by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) are excluded from competition.

10. Finals:

The heats and direct decisions will be set on 10 lanes according to entry times. These should be current (not older than 12 months). Training times are possible if there are no official times.

In the competitions listed as finals, there will be an open international A and B final (IDM final) and an international youth final (IDM youth final). The finals will only be held if at least six swimmers have qualified for them and there are no withdrawals for them.

Swimmers from the heats qualify for the finals according to the 1000-point table of the DBS – Para Swimming Department as follows:

The 10 swimmers with the best points qualify for the IDM A final. The 11-20 swimmers with the most points qualify for the IDM B final. Three swimmers are named as reserves.

The 10 swimmers with the most points in the youth classes who have not qualified for the IDM A or B finals qualify for the IDM Youth Finals. IDM A or B finals are included in the scoring of the “International German Youth Champion”. Three reserve swimmers are named. The final qualifications, including the withdrawal deadline and location, will be announced by notice and announcement. Withdrawals submitted before the announcement of the qualifications will not be accepted. Reserve swimmers will only move up if there have been withdrawals by the corresponding withdrawal deadline.

12. Entry Results:

The preliminary and final entry results and lists will be published on the [event website](#). They will be available for download in printable form. The final entry results will only be published on the websites after the technical meeting. Changes due to classifications will be considered.

13. Training:

Limited training times are available at pre-arranged times from 04 May to 09 May 2026. Lanes will be allocated according to the training schedule and must be adhered to.

Warm up on competition days for heats and finals is available in the competition pool and training pool.

Warm up times in the competition pool are below:

Heats: 07:30 - 08:45

Finals: 15:30 - 16:45

All athletes must follow the warmup signage in place for the safety of all swimmers.

Warmup lane allocations will also be shared in the technical meeting.

The warmup pool stays open until half an hour following the finish of the session for swim down.

14. Technical Meeting:

The Technical Meeting will take place on Saturday, 09 May 2026, at 15:00. Any deviations from the announcement or the rules in the competition regulations will be announced here by the Technical Delegate (TD). Any previous announcements not published here will thus lose their validity.

15. Sport Information Desk (SID)

A Sport Information Desk will operate at the competition venue on the days of competition, as well as during any scheduled training sessions. It is the primary and only point of distribution for all event related information including the following:

- Distribution of start lists for the NPCs (digital only);
- Official communication with teams;
- Official forms distribution (Relay Declaration Form, Protest Form, Medical Withdrawal Form);
- Liaison between teams and LOC.

16. Accreditation

For team accreditation you need to register your team through the mentioned online entry portal. Accreditation cards will be provided to each team based on the listing made through the online entry portal. Accreditation cards will be needed on competition days to enter the venue and the competition areas. Athletes must bring their accreditation cards to enter the call room! Without showing the card, access to the venue will not be possible.

The cards can be picked up at the accreditation office from 04 May 2026. The accreditation office can be found at the athletes' entrance.

In case an accreditation card gets lost, a replacement card can be asked for at the accreditation office. There will be a fee of **EUR 20** to be paid cash on site to replace an accreditation card.

18. Classification

International classification will be offered by World Para Swimming for swimmers only entered for World Para Swimming World Series Berlin. Please check the relevant entry pack and take care to enter the relevant swimmers at the

[IPC SDMS Online Entry system](#).

19. Ice Baths Massage Tables & Race analysis

Ice baths will not be available. A registration is necessary to do physiotherapy or massages. Areas will be foreseen for these kinds of treatments.

There is a race analysis area on the second level on the athletes' site of the venue. Tables and power plugs will be available earliest from Wednesday, 06 May 2026.

Please do not use the glass doors in the race analysis area as an exit, as they are alarm-secured.

20. Changing Rooms

Changing rooms are available at the competition level and next to the warm-up pool. Both sets of changing rooms have accessible facilities as well. Please follow the signs.

21. Victory Ceremonies

The individual competitions are scored across all starting classes. The basis for scoring is the conversion of time into points according to the current 1000-point table of the Para Swimming Department of the DBS e.V. The following scores are then awarded based on the points achieved:

“International/German Champion”

IDM A finals and direct decisions: Scoring according to the 1000-point table, places 1-3 medals, places 1-10 certificates.

The relay scoring is open according to points. The 1000-point times of the individual relay participants are added up according to their respective starting class for the respective distance/discipline. The sum forms the 1000-point time, which is then used to calculate the corresponding total points. The relay team with the highest number of points is the competition winner. Places 1-3 receive medals and certificates.

“International German Youth Champion”

IDM Youth Finals and direct decisions, scoring for youth (A - D) according to the 1000-point table, places 1-3 medals, places 1-10 certificates, performances of swimmers in youth A-D from the IDM A or B finals are included in the scoring.

The award ceremonies for the finals and direct decisions will generally be held during the final segments. The time of the award ceremony can be found in the schedules. The ceremonies are an essential part of the competition.

22. Anti-Doping

Doping is prohibited under the provisions of the DBS. The Anti-Doping Code of the DBS and the regulations of WADA and NADA apply. By submitting the registration form for the event, the participant accepts the anti-doping regulations in their currently valid version (available at www.dbs-npc.de). Doping controls may be carried out on a random basis. By submitting their registration for the event, participants acknowledge the jurisdiction of NADA for the results management procedure and disciplinary proceedings in accordance with the NADA Code for disputes arising from and in connection with the anti-doping regulations, and the jurisdiction of the German Sports Arbitration Court at the German Institution of Arbitration in Cologne for contentious proceedings in the first instance, including for interim legal protection, in accordance with the DIS Sports Arbitration Rules, to the exclusion of ordinary legal recourse. instance, including for interim legal protection, in accordance with the DIS Sports Arbitration Rules, to the exclusion of ordinary legal recourse.
